Tuberculosis Test	Mandatory only for the students who stay in the

	- Students need to take the test before they come to Korea	
	(within 1 month) if they stay in a dormitory.	
Health Insurance	Compulsory	
Ticaliti Insurance	- All international students must have national insurance of	
	the Republic of Korea (about \$70 every month).

	- Students may individually purchase traveler's insurance.

Housing	Dormitory application:	
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- General Hall	(2 persons/room)
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a. With two meals a day: KRW 1,501,000
